- Applicant must be of Hispanic descent and a legal resident of **Racine County**.
- Applicant must have a grade point average of 2.7 (on a four point scale).
- Applicant must have been involved in school AND community activities.
- Applicant must be a high school senior or graduate or be currently enrolled in an accredited college, technical college or university in **Wisconsin**.
- Scholarships of \$500 will be credited towards eligible recipient's student accounts for the fall semester, 2012, **in a Wisconsin public institution**. If recipient of scholarship drops out before completing the semester, the recipient would need to refund the full scholarship to the HBPA.

 2. Why you are applying for this scholarship.
 3. What your career goals are.
 4. What you feel is needed in the Latino community and how you might help to meet those needs.
- Two letters of recommendation (from counselor, high school teachers or college professors) These letters must be sent directly to the HBPA by the person signing them and must be received by the deadline date.
